In supporting sustainability consider:

As you look through the following list, consider making supply choices that support sustainability. General strategies include:

REDUCE: When applicable, seek items that are marked non-toxic.

REUSE: Use items from previous years

RECYCLE: Choose items with recycled and recyclable content

- 1 container of Band-aids
- 1 pkg. construction paper
- 1 pair scissors (jr or adult size)
- 1 pkg fine point Sharpies (black)
- 1 pkg ultra fine point sharpies (black)
- 3 pkgs #2 pencils (doz.)
- 1- 1" binder w/ clear document holder on front
- 1- 2" binder with clear document holder on front
- 1 pkg card stock (any color or white)
- 2 reams colored copy paper
- 3 reams white copy paper
- 1 roll blue or green painters tape
- 1 pkg highlighters
- Hand Sanitizer
- 8-10 Glue sticks
- 3 big pink erasers
- 2 boxes Kleenex
- Expo or dry-Erase pens (4 to 8 pens)
- 1 twelve inch wooden ruler (in and cm)
- 1 pkg. lined 3x5 note cards
- 1 Roll Scotch Tape
- 1 black & white composition notebook
- 2 pkgs wide ruled notebook paper
- 6 3-hole pronged pocket folders (any colors)
- 5 wide ruled spiral notebooks
- 1 pkg plain sponges (no scrubber sides)
- White Out
- 1 pkg graph paper
- Box of Red Pencils
- Box of Red ball point Pens
